- __ when necessary, help organize classroom events such as potlucks.
- __ help disseminate information to classroom parents.
- __ help the teacher find parent volunteers for classroom field trips or projects.
- __ welcome any new parents to the classroom during the school year.

They brainstorm ideas and share what works. However, it's not necessary to attend monthly meetings to be a Room Parent.
